PURPOSE

To recognize outstanding design achievement by an interior design student who best represents the Theresa Bradley Spirit.

CRITERIA

The judges will award the internship based upon creative, academic, and leadership accomplishments as demonstrated by a portfolio submission, academic transcripts, letters of recommendation from faculty, and a one-page biography.

AWARD / RECOGNITION

- ◆ Winner will be announced at the Design Awareness Event in Salt Lake City on March 24, 2005.
- ◆ Winner will receive a specially designed trophy.
- ◆ Winner will be awarded a \$2,000 cash prize.
- ◆ Winner will be flown to Calgary for a three-day, all expenses paid learning vacation where HAWORTH will provide an insider's view of commercial interior design, everything from initial drawings to manufactured product being shipped to the client. HAWORTH will provide world-class accommodation in HAWORTH'S client complex called "Falkridge" (<http://www.smednet.com/company/falkridge.asp>). Nestled in the Rocky Mountains, Falkridge is a testament to design and luxury. The winner will experience the expertise of world renowned chefs and highly trained and helpful staff. SELECTION PROCESS

- ◆ Each applicant will make a submittal to the design department at their respective schools.
- ◆ Each School will select two finalists and forward their submittal to the Theresa Bradley Spirit Committee.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Minimum of 3.2 GPA.
- ◆ Applicant must be a 3rd year student of interior design at Utah State University, Brigham Young University, Weber State University, or BYU Idaho.
- ◆ Submittal must include the following:
 - § Completed entry form
 - § An official transcript (or official copy) of grades with cumulative GPA highlighted
 - § Two letters of recommendation from members of the interior design faculty
 - § One page student biography highlighting personal accomplishments, interests and goals
 - § Portfolio with class project showing floor plan including furniture layout, perspective/rendering, fabric board, and project description including size, scope, functional requirements, and aesthetic requirements
 - § Submittal must be delivered to the Theresa Bradley Spirit Committee by March 1, 2005. The design departments at each university will determine the submission date for their applicants.
- ◆ The winner must attend the March 24, 2005 Award Presentation in order to receive the award.
- ◆ The decision of the judges is final.
- ◆ If in the opinion of the jury, no entry meets the minimum criteria of the competition, no award will be made.
